Selection process

In accordance with article 8 of the REGULATORY AGREEMENT 145140 of 15th June 2022 that approves the regulation governing the recruitment of research staff under chapter 6 allocation of the university budget, as well as technical or operational research staff. A personal interview will be held where the candidate's suitability for the work dynamic in the Research Area will be assessed, looking at their collaborative skills, ability for teamwork, decision-making, proactiveness and the ability to take on responsibilities.

Eligibility criteria:

- Curricular merits in the field (max. 40 points).
- Qualifications in the specialist area (max. 20 points), other (max. 5 points).
- Video curriculum and, if applicable, personal interview (max. 20 points).



- Experience in the field (max. 15 points). E.g.: > 3 years (10 points), < 3 years (5 points).
 - Other merits (max. +5 points). E.g.: recommendation letters.
- Eligibility threshold: 60 points.
